Annual General Meeting Wednesday, March 23, 2022

1. CALL TO ORDER

S. Hamilton welcomed all Members present. She wished everyone health and safety and acknowledged the meeting is being facilitated differently than usual, but will continue executing IGNITE's responsibilities, timely and transparently, even under these extenuating circumstances. Members were asked to sign-in via a link provided in the Q&A function to enter first name, last name, student number and email address. Votes will be recorded and accounted for in the Q&A function with motions to approve, second and opposing votes only.

CEO presented land acknowledgement.

Chairperson, S. Hamilton, called the meeting to order at 11:03 a.m.

5. PRESENTATION OF THE 2021-2022 IMPACT REPORT

Chairperson presented the 2021-2022 Impact Report, expressed her pride in this year's report and the organization's accomplishments. Highlights of the presentation included:

- Information presented does not yet include all initiatives achieved in March 2022 so an updated Impact Report will be provided at fiscal year-end.
- Supported and serviced thousands of students across all fee categories such as career success, social opportunities, well-being and financial security and leadership and advocacy.
- Leadership and Advocacy
 - Awarded 15 students with scholarships including two brand new scholarships introduced this past year: the IGNITE Pride Scholarship and the IGNITE Indigenous Scholarship.
 - Advocated for issues regarding distance learning, returning to campus, health and safety of students and the bargaining situation between the CEC and OPSEU.
- Career Success
 - Provided over 250 students with bursaries to fund additional program-specific equipment through the learning essentials support.
 - Assisted over 200 students develop new skills and certifications through the Skills Bundle Program and continue to give students the opportunities needed to succeed in future careers.
- Well-being and financial aid
 - Distributed over 1200 free containers of frozen soup, provided over 396 free menstrual kits to students, supported 14 students dealing with unique financial situations with Financial Relief Program and provided over 28,553 students with health and dental insurance.
- Chairperson acknowledged this year has been a challenging time for all post-secondary students, with increased stress, it being far from an ideal school-year and why IGNITE continues to target bettering student lives with various social opportunities. Distributed over 200 mystery boxes, awarded over \$5,700 in prizes on the IGNITE Spin Wheel and



hosted hundreds of students at virtual frosh and frost concerts. Partnered with various Humber and UofGH departments to create the best school environment possible, including a contribution of \$100,000 to Humber's Office of Sustainability reusable O2GO Food container program.

6. PRESENTATION OF THE 2022-2023 BUDGET

Tara DeFrancesco, Director of Finance and Administration, presented the F23 Budget.

- Revenues:
 - Ancillary revenues comparable to prior year with earned interest consisting of interest earned on balance of funds help with Humber and interest earned on GIC investments.
 - Ticket sales planned for in-person events has been budgeted for.
 - Commercial revenues are down as no longer have agenda advertising contract, continue to have rental income and grad photograph contract in place.
 - Three of four mandatory fee categories will operate at \$45K surplus. Surpluses achieved by the choice to not carry out IGNITION point video series. Intentional surpluses are to offset \$135K deficit of the Membership fee category.
 - Insurance program will operate a \$158K deficit as a 1-year contract with existing health and dental insurance provider has been secured while the organization carries out an extensive RFP process.

- Expenses:

- Career Success and Advocacy and Leadership fees small increase of \$0.50 and \$1, respectively. Returning fees to previous rate, prior to their reduction during the pandemic.
- Marketing and Communications decreased for Career Success, Well-being & Financial Security and Advocacy & Leadership.
- Administration expenses increased \$300K to budget toward moving to an inperson environment, including training and development for IGNITE staff.
- Total of category expenses \$5.94M, equal and balanced to the revenue expected to be collected.
- Current Health & Dental fee for students is \$104.24, remaining unchanged from last year. However, cost to execute health and dental plan amounts to \$106.37 per student, fee cannot be changed at this time therefore IGNITE will bearing the cost for students, total approx. \$158K, representing the operating deficit of IGNITE. Deficit will be funded through the unreserved fund, expected balance to be \$5M after F22 has concluded.

7. APPROVAL OF 2022-2023 FINANCIAL AUDITORS

S. Hamilton affirmed BDO Canada LLP has been the auditing company for Humber ITAL and IGNITE Student Union for over ten years.
